

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given of a Public Hearing by Bucks County Industrial Development Authority (the "Authority"), on behalf of itself and the County Commissioners (the "Commissioners") of Bucks County, Pennsylvania, to be held on May 3, 2019 at 9:00 a.m. in the Office of the Authority's Counsel, Begley, Carlin & Mandio, LLP at 680 Middletown Boulevard, Langhorne, Pennsylvania 19047. Such hearing will be conducted for the purpose of receiving public comment with respect to the proposed issuance by the Authority of tax-exempt revenue bonds (the "Bonds") to finance a project in Bucks County on behalf of George School as follows:

- A. **Initial Legal Owner or Principal User:** George School (the "School"), a Pennsylvania nonprofit corporation and an organization described in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), which operates a nonprofit, independent secondary school.
- B. **Maximum Stated Principal Amount of Bonds:** \$20,000,000.
- C. **Description of Project:** The Project consists of the issuance of qualified 501(c)(3) bonds as defined in Section 145 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, to finance and refinance educational facilities and working capital expenditures (the "Project").
- D. **Location of the Project:** The Project facilities described above are located on the campus of the George School with a campus address of 1690 Newtown Langhorne Road, Newtown, PA 18940. The campus is bounded to the North by Route 332 (Newtown Bypass), to the East by Route 413 (Newtown Langhorne Road) and to the South by Newtown Friends School and Pennswood Village retirement community.

This notice is published and the public hearing is being held by and on behalf of the Authority as issuer of the Bonds, as required by section 147(f) of the Code and regulations promulgated thereunder.
