ORDER

AND NOW, this *20<sup>th</sup>* day of March, 2020, consistent with the Orders of March 17, 2020, and March 19, 2020, entered by the Honorable Wallace H. Bateman, Jr., President Judge of the Court of Common Pleas of the Seventh Judicial District, it is hereby ordered that Paragraph 3 of Administrative Order No. 19, Protection From Abuse Actions, is amended as follows:


3. Emergency orders for protection pursuant to either the Protection From Abuse Act or Protection of Victims of Sexual Violence or Intimidation Act may be issued by a Magisterial District Judge at the following times:

(a) on Monday through Thursday, from 1 p.m. until 8 a.m. on the next day the Court of Common Pleas is open for business; and

(b) during weekend periods, from 1:00 p.m. on Friday (or otherwise, 1:00 p.m. on the last day of the week on which the Court of Common Pleas is open for business) to 8 a.m. on the next day the Court of Common Pleas is open for business.

This order is effective immediately, and unless extended by further order shall expire at the close of business April 14, 2020.
