AN ORDINANCE TO PLACE BEFORE THE ELECTORS OF BUCKS COUNTY THE BALLOT QUESTION PROVIDED BY THE "HOME RULE CHARTER AND OPTIONAL PLANS LAW"

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Commissioners of Bucks County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1. That at the November 7, 1972 General Election there be made a determination by the electors of Bucks County as to whether or not a Government Study Commission of eleven members shall be elected to study the charter and form of government of Bucks County, to study and draft a Home Rule Charter and to recommend whether or not a Home Rule Charter should be adopted.

SECTION 2. The Chief Clerk shall within five (5) days of the final enactment of this Ordinance file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the Bucks County Board of Elections, together with a copy of the question to be submitted to the electors, which shall be as follows: "Shall a Government Study Commission of eleven members be elected to study the charter and form of government of Bucks County, Pennsylvania, to study and draft a Home Rule Charter and to recommend whether or not a Home Rule Charter should be adopted?"

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is adopted under authority of the Act of the General Assembly of April , 1972 (Act No. 62) known as the "Home Rule Charter and Optional Plans Law".
