

PUBLIC NOTICE

ORDINANCE NO. 41

AN ORDINANCE TO PLACE BEFORE THE ELECTORS OF BUCKS COUNTY THE BALLOT QUESTION PROVIDED BY THE "HOME RULE CHARTER AND OPTIONAL PLANS LAW"

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Commissioners of Bucks County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1. That at the May 17, 1977 Primary Election there be made a determination by the electors of Bucks County as to whether or not a Government Study Commission of seven members shall be elected to study the charter and form of government of Bucks County, to consider the advisability of the adoption of a Home Rule Charter or an optional form of government should be adopted.

SECTION 2. The Chief Clerk shall within five (5) days of the final enactment of this Ordinance file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the Bucks County Board of Elections, together with a copy of the question to be submitted to the electors, which shall be as follows:

"Shall a government study commission of seven members be elected to study the existing form of government of the municipality; to consider the advisability of the adoption of an optional form of government or a home rule charter; to recommend the adoption of an optional form of government; or to draft and recommend a home rule charter?"

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is adopted under authority of the Act of the General Assembly of April , 1972 (Act No. 62) known as the "Home Rule Charter and Optional Plans Law" (53 P.S.1201).
