ORDINANCE NO. 80A

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 80 ENACTED JUNE 19, 1991 ENTITLED "FLOW CONTROL ORDINANCE FOR MUNICIPAL WASTE AND SOURCE-SEPARATED RECYCLABLES," BY DELETING THEREFROM CERTAIN REFERENCES TO "SOURCE-SEPARATED RECYCLABLES"

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners (the "Board") of the County of Bucks, Pennsylvania (the "County") enacted Ordinance No. 80 on June 19, 1991 establishing the Flow Control Ordinance for Municipal Waste and Source-Separated Recyclables:

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the requirement that all source-separated recyclables generated in the County be directed only to recycling facilities designated by the Bucks County Municipal Waste Management Plan is not necessary.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted and ordained by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Bucks, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as follows:

SECTION 1:

The nomenclature "Source-Separated Recyclables" shall be deleted from the following sections of Ordinance No. 80:

- a. Section 4.1
- b. Section 4.3
- c. Section 5.3
- d. Section 7.3
- e. Section 9.2 D


SECTION 2:
