- In accordance with the Criminal History Records Information Act (“CHRIA”), the Department of Corrections (“DOC”) shall complete and attach this form to any disclosure of criminal history record information.
 - Criminal history record information is “Information collected by criminal justice agencies concerning individuals, and arising from the initiation of a criminal proceeding, consisting of identifiable descriptions, dates and notations of arrests, indictments, informations or other formal criminal charges and any dispositions arising therefrom. The term does not include intelligence information, investigative information or treatment information, including medical and psychological information, or information and records specified in section 9104 (relating to scope).”
 - A DOC representative shall sign and date at the bottom of this form.
