



Now in its second year, the Bucks County Veteran ID Discount Card Program has processed over 6,000 identification cards and added over 500 participating vendors, with additional veterans and businesses coming onboard each day.

Bucks County veterans and active duty personnel are continually encouraged to become part of the Veteran ID Discount Card Program. By showing their original DD-214 discharge form or Certificate of Honorable Military Discharge papers (or having staff look it up if already filed in the county Recorder of Deeds office), individuals will receive a color photo identification card that will entitle them to special discounts and offers at local businesses. Those that are interested can visit the Recorder of Deeds office at the Bucks County Courthouse in Doylestown or attend special Veteran ID events, scheduled throughout the year.

Rewarding a veteran's sacrifice and service




A way to give back to those who bravely served our country.

An innovative program that provides Bucks County's 60,000 United States Armed Forces veterans and active duty personnel with a photo ID card to receive special discounts at local businesses.

On November 1, 2011, our county began participating in a Veterans Discount Card program. This program is supported by the Board of Bucks County Commissioners, the county Recorder of Deeds office and the county Military/Veterans Affairs office.

This program will offer your business a chance to be one of the Bucks County pioneers in furthering a "veteran friendly" purchasing opportunity for those who have served our country. We ask county business owners to consider providing a special offer to veterans that present their ID card. The offer can be a percentage discount or special monetary reduction. These clearly marked ID cards will be issued by the Bucks County Recorder of Deeds office, which also files DD-214 forms and Certificate of Honorable Military Discharge papers. All participants will be cleared through the Veterans Discount Card application process and accompanying paperwork.

We look forward to promoting your business as a participant in this proven successful program. Veterans are eager to be part of this initiative, and you have the chance to be a pioneer in this venture.
