




# Stormwater Management

## NPDES PAG-13 Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) Permit Resources



The National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Pennsylvania permit (PAG-13), requires municipalities to develop stormwater programs to prevent pollutants from entering Pennsylvania's streams and waterways through stormwater runoff.
