**AGREEMENT**

The parties enter this agreement with the goal of serving the best interests of

The parties request that the terms and provisions of this agreement be entered  
as an order of court. They acknowledge that Pennsylvania is the home state of the  
child/children, and that the Court of Common Pleas of Bucks County, PA has jurisdiction

to enter the provisions of this agreement as an order. The parties acknowledge that violation of a custody order may subject the parent in violation to civil and/or criminal penalties.

\_\_\_\_\_ shall have primary physical custody subject to partial physical custody in \_\_\_\_\_ as set out below.

The child/children shall not hear either parent insult, criticize or say nasty things about the other. The parties acknowledge that failure to comply with this provision may be considered by the court to be irresponsible behavior in a parent.

The parties shall provide no less than 30 days advance notice to each other of address changes.

If a parent plans to relocate to an address that would make it impractical for the family to comply with the terms and provisions of this agreement, it is the responsibility of that parent to initiate proceedings for modification sufficiently in advance to permit a modified order to be entered prior to the relocation. The parties acknowledge that failure to comply with this provision, whether by a primary physical custodian or by a partial physical custodian, risk unnecessary disruption of the child's life and unnecessary exposure of the child to parental conflict.

Neither parent shall remove the child/children from the continental United States without written agreement of the other parent or leave of court.
