ORDINANCE NO. 8

SIGNIFYING THE INTENTION AND DESIRE OF THE MUNICIPAL AUTHORITIES OF THE COUNTY OF BUCKS, PENNSYLVANIA, TO ORGANIZE AN AUTHORITY UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE ACT OF MAY 2, 1945, P.L. 382, AS AMENDED: SETTING FORTH THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION; SPECIFYING THE INITIAL PROJECT TO BE UNDERTAKEN BY THE AUTHORITY; AND APPOINTING THE FIRST MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF THE AUTHORITY AND FIXING THE TERMS THEREOF.

The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Bucks, Pennsylvania, hereby ordains that:

Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners hereby signifies its intention and desire to organize an Authority under the provisions of the "Municipality Authorities Act of 1945", as amended.

Section 2. The Chairmen and the Chief Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners are hereby authorized and directed to execute on behalf of the County of Bucks Articles of Incorporation for said Authority, in substantially the following form:

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE COMMONWEALTH,
COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA

In compliance with the requirements of the Act of May 2, 1945, P.L. 382, known as "Municipality Authorities Act of 1945", as amended, the County of Bucks, Pennsylvania, desiring to incorporate an Authority thereunder, does hereby certify:

1. The name of the Authority is Bucks County Community College Authority.
2. Said Authority is formed under the provisions of the Act of May 2, 1945, P.L. 382, as amended.
3. The "Bucks County Airport Authority" and the "Bucks County Water and Sewer Authority" have been organized under the said Municipality Authorities Act of 1945 and are the only Authorities in existence in or for the County of Bucks, the incorporating municipality herein, organized under said Act or the Act approved the 28th day of June, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Five (Pamphlet Laws 463).
4. The name of the incorporating municipality is the County of Bucks, Pennsylvania.
5. The names and addresses of its municipal authorities are as follows:

undertaken by the said Authority is: To acquire, hold, construct, improve, maintain and operate, own lease, either in the capacity of Lessor or Lessee, buildings to be devoted wholly or partially for public uses, and all facilities necessary or incident thereto, for ~~Further~~ ^{FURTHERING-~~the~~} public post-secondary education and training.

Section 6. The following named persons be and they hereby are appointed as the first members of the Board of the Authority, whose terms of office shall commence on the date of appointment and shall be computed from January 1, 1966:

Section 7. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby expressly repealed.


