The Benefits of Volunteering

RSVP has more than 750 volunteers working in 130 non-profit organizations throughout Bucks County. Each year, these valued volunteers contribute more than 125,000 hours of service to the Bucks community!

The *Corporation for National and Community Service* states, “A growing body of research indicates that volunteering provides individual health benefits in addition to social benefits. This research has established a strong relationship between volunteering and health: those who volunteer have lower mortality rates, greater functional ability, and lower rates of depression later in life than those who do not volunteer. Older volunteers are the most likely to receive greater benefits from volunteering, whether they are more likely to face higher incidence of illness or because volunteering provides them with physical and social activity and a sense of purpose at a time when their social roles are changing. Some of these findings also indicate that volunteers who devote a ‘considerable’ amount of time to volunteer activities (approximately 100 hours per year) are most likely to exhibit positive health outcomes.”

Bowman's Hill Wildflower Preserve

Established under the direction of the Council for Preservation of Natural Beauty and the Federation of Garden Clubs in Pennsylvania, it instills in people a greater appreciation of native plants, an understanding of their importance to all life, and a commitment to the preservation of a healthy and diverse natural world.
