Within 30 days of the date provided above for the filing of Responses to Dispositive Motions and only upon agreement of all parties, any party may file a Praeceptum for a Date Certain Case Management Conference in a form required by the Office of the Court Administrator - Calendar. Said Praeceptum shall be accompanied by a Date Certain Pre-Trial Conference Scheduling Order. A courtesy copy of the Praeceptum and Scheduling Order shall be submitted to the Chambers of the Honorable Robert O. Baldi and to the Office of the Court Administrator, Calendar.
